Clips come from amateur films, newsreels, documentaries and advertising.

Local items include Queenstown Bay and the *TSS Earnslaw* in about 1914; Skippers Road, the Bowls Club, and filming from Ben Lomond in 1925-6; films by tramper and climber Scott Gilkison in the 1940s and 50s; and 'A Wet Day in Paradise' documentary in 1994 including Rosie Grant.
