 Otago Fish and Game council rules must be abided by
 Fish must be caught on the day
 Entries will not be accepted after 10am on the day
 Weigh in closes at 4pm sharp
 Entrants are entitled to weigh in **one** fish per person
Entrants must weigh-in their own fish or fish *may* be accepted by the judges if it is clearly bagged and named prior to arriving to the weigh-in
 Fish should not be gutted before weigh in
Family entries must be immediate family and include at least one school aged child 18 years or under
 The judge's decision is final.
