- Weigh in closes at 4pm sharp
- Entrants are entitled to weigh in **one** fish per person
- Entrants must weigh-in their own fish or fish may be accepted by the judges if it is clearly bagged and named prior to arriving to the weigh-in
- Fish should **not be gutted** before weigh-in
- A **Family entry** may include a couple, either parents or grandparents, and up to 4 children or grandchildren under the age of 18. Entries must include at least one school aged child.
