#### 9.1 Glenorchy Community vision and values

The Shaping our Future steering group have agreed the report from the Glenorchy visioning workshops and the recommendations of the Glenorchy Task Force. There are a number of actions and recommendations in the report that fall to the GCA and the motion on the agenda will authorise the GCA to act upon them.

**Motion**: "That the GCA supports the vision and recommendations of the Shaping our Future task force report and as a first step agrees to :- I) ensure decisions made by the GCA will move the community towards the vision:

- ii) establish a working group to review how the GCA functions, runs meetings and engages with and represents the community
- iii) meet with Sustainable Glenorchy and the QLDC in order to agree a wastewater management framework that leads the way in environmentally sound long term solutions;
- lv) hold a public meeting to discuss establishment of community gardens, and v) hold a public meeting to explore options for taking forward the recommendations and vision relating to our economy and economic activity"

#### 9.2 Chlorination

**Motion**: "That the GCA is strongly opposed to the chlorination of the town water supply and believes QLDC should immediately prioritise overdue improvements to the town water supply and reticulation"

## 9.3 Wastewater

Council have been gathering information about existing wastewater systems in the town and will have a report in August. They have announced that they will consult the community on Councils preferred scheme through the 10 year plan review process next year.

**Motion:** "that the GCA seek a meeting with Council to review the results of their investigations in the township"
