Summary of New Royal Horticultural Society Daffodil Classification

- 1 "Coloured" means yellow or some colour other than white
- 2 "White" means white or whitish
- The length of the perianth segment is the extreme length measured on the inside from its junction with cup along the mid-rib to the extreme tip and the length of the cup is the extreme length measured from its junction with the perianth to the end of its furthermost extension when the edge is flattened out

DIVISION I – Trumpet Narcissi of Garden Origin

Distinguishing character – one flower to a stem, trumpet as long as or longer than the perianth segments

- (a) Perianth coloured, trumpet coloured, not paler than perianth
- (b) Perianth white, trumpet coloured
- (c) Perianth white, trumpet coloured, not paler than perianth
- (d) Any colour combination not falling into (a), (b) or (c)

DIVISION II – Large-cupped Narcissi of Garden Origin

Distinguishing character – one flower to stem, cup not less than $1/3^{rd}$ but less than equal to the length of the perianth segments

- (a) Perianth coloured, cup coloured, not paler than perianth
- (b) Perianth white, cup coloured
- (c) Perianth white, cup white, not paler than perianth
- (d) Any colour combination not falling into (a), (b) or (c)

DIVISION III – Small-cupped Narcissi of Garden Origin

Distinguishing character – one flower to stem, cup $1/3^{rd}$ or less, and less than equal to the length of the perianth segments

- (a) Perianth coloured, cup coloured, not paler than perianth
- (b) Perianth white, cup coloured
- (c) Perianth white, cup white, not paler than perianth
- (d) Any colour combination not falling into (a), (b) or (c)
