

CLOSURE OF STREETS TO ORDINARY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1974, notice is hereby given that consideration will be given by the Queenstown Lakes District Council under delegated authority, to the closure of the following roads to ordinary vehicular traffic for the purpose of **Filming on the Dart River Bridge, Glenorchy**:
