#### 7.6 Wastewater management - provision of baseline information

Progress to obtain baseline information around the effects of discharges from current treatment regime in the town is dragging on.

The community needs to understand the extent of any "gap" that might need to be bridged between the existing arrangements and impending ORC standards before it can consider how such a gap might be bridged.

The GCA should consider setting a forward date by which it expects appropriate and uncontested information to be collated and provided around existing effects and to



direct engagement with ORC in order to gather an indication of likely future discharge requirements.
