#### Inward correspondence

Responsible camping Bylaw has taken effect, with camping in the township behind the hall in the parking lot

Mayor John Glover has asked some QLDC staff for some info from his officers about the heavy rain event that took place in November, to have a meeting with GCA members and Pete Reid on future flood protection for the township  
ORC sent a response to the flood protection GCA requested on behalf of Councillor Stephen Brent, noting:

“At a high level managing flood hazards is a task that multiple parties contribute to. Broadly speaking, we (ORC) look after high level assessment and monitoring of hazards, and where beneficial manage rivers to ensure they are flowing efficiently and some cases we (ORC) look after flood defense structures. Territorial Authorities (IE QLDC) look after urban stormwater and in some cases (this being one) flood defense structures.”

January:

Sarah Grohnert has expressed interest in making a documentary about Glenorchy, and is looking for endorsement from the community

Aurora Energy announced the Queenstown zone substation upgrade is now complete, which strengthens the power supply in Queenstown and Glenorchy

Received a quote of \$18,000 for a wifi enabled dosing system and plant upgrade for the pool from Poolwerx

Downer was working on culvert replacement works on the Greenstone/Kinloch road

The next Long Term Plan is taking feedback until February 8th. Submissions can be submitted through the QLDC Lets Talk page

Zero Waste Glenorchy wants to organize local management and periodic cleanup of the Greenwaste, with assistance from QLDC, and reduce the use of outside contractors

AbleMinds from Queenstown is looking to collaborate to support Glenorchy Students

QLDC - Sent proposed landing for the Glenorchy Aerodrome for concession holders

Shot Productions are filming in Paradise the 11-26 February, there will be periodic traffic control in place from Diamond Lake to Cassells Creek during that time. Dust suppression will be in effect during that time

Steve Hewland wants to present plans on behalf of the GY Trails Trust and Glenorchy Trail Alliance for a trail linking Glenorchy and Queenstown at the March GCA meeting

Did not accept the quote of \$18,000 from Poolwerx for the plant upgrade and wifi enabled dosing machine. The group of volunteers are handling the water testing without any issue. May look into other options at another date

#### **7.3 Greenwaste Update**

Dan Nogueira has suggested a local digger can spend a few hours every couple months cleaning up the green waste site, which could diminish the cost of having contractors come from out of town to clean it up. He also has access to a chipper which he can use to help out the community composting scheme, and has asked if QLDC is able to help by providing a tip truck or truck and trailer. Delta is helpful with chipping, but takes all the product back to Queenstown, rather than leaving it in the community
