## **7.3 Glenorchy Road Speed Limits**

## **7.4 Fresh drinking water fountain at the hall**

## **7.5 Native plant nursery update**

The Native Plant nursery submitted their historical financial figures. As of 20/3/26 the nursery has \$29,340. Since the Nursery was started in 2021, the nursery has grown and planted thousands of native plants, had community planting days, and helped offset film carbon emissions
