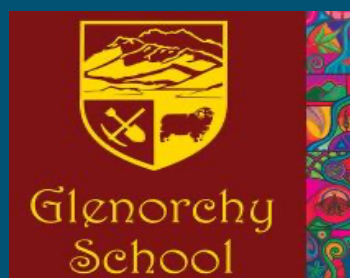
Electoral roll. The electoral roll is held at the school office and can be viewed during normal school hours.

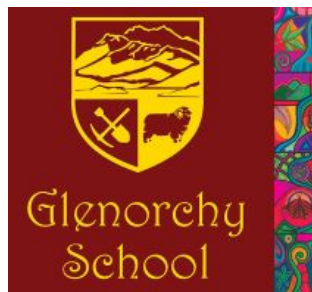
