#### 7. General business

## 7.1 Cantire Street: proposal to make one way

This was discussed briefly at the last meeting but the committee wish to hear views on the suggestion. Making the street one way with traffic direction being from the pool up to Oban Street is supported by the school on safety grounds. If the GCA agree to the suggestion, the next step would be to raise it with QLDC.



This was supported by the committee and it will be raised at the Mayor/CE visit. A good suggestion was to produce an overview of the area showing the issues and outcomes to address.

# 7.2 Greenwaste: changes needed to manage the site

The greenwaste site is in a bit of disarray with building waste, plastics and dead animals all being dumped along with large root balls, stumps and very large tree sections, none of which should be dumped there. Most of the waste is not being sorted and grass clippings raise the question of spray residue entering the greenwaste. The site is also overgrown with convolvulus and hemlock. What useful compost that eventuates has also been removed in large volumes with truck and digger, contrary to how the site is supposed to operate.

It was agreed to request a site meeting with QLDC. A group comprising Thor & Corrine, Dan from Zero Waste GY, J Scott for the GCA and a rep from Sustainable Glenorchy was suggested to review the site and it's operations.

## 7.3 GY airstrip update following recent governance committee meeting

The strip has been rolled but limited effect. There are rabbit & deer issues. Landings allocated represent 60% of capacity. QLDC will notify RMP early April and aim to adopt in August.

# 7.4 Welcome to Glenorchy sign: should it be replaced?

We have had no input from anyone supporting replacement of this sign so no further action is proposed.

#### 7.5 Pool update

The committee agreed we should aim to operate under the Quality Pools standard for next season. Aim to close by Easter this year. We should request quotes for work to be done over the winter. Going forward we should probably look at the pool in its own right as to what improvements could be done. Naomi to put funding request together and apply on behalf of the GCA to the Glenorchy Community Trust.

### 7.6 Nursery update

We are due to set a date for our autumn planting. The organisation Trees That Count are due to fund 500 plants out of the nursery to be planted. It is hoped that the current film production may use plants from the nursery to counter the carbon they will have produced at the head of the lake. A planting agreement is being drawn up with QLDC which will enable them to support our efforts with the loan of augers and provision of materials etc.
