Our swimming programme started last week with Mrs Green and it has been great to see the progress all the students are making by participating in daily lessons. The children need to bring their swimming togs every day this week. Next week we will be swimming on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

We have a new structure for our Social Worker in Schools (SWIS) programme this year. Fee Stephenson has taken on a new role in the organisation and so we currently have Vicky and Lindsay coming out to Glenorchy School on Tuesdays. They are taking a series of whole class sessions with our students covering topics such as the brain, coping with feeling nervous/anxious, knowing and identifying big feelings, strategies for coping or dealing with those feelings, relating to others and conflict resolution. Following this, Vicky will be available to take individual sessions with students as required.

It was also great to have Pip and Harold the Giraffe here in the first week of term 1 to work with our students. Pip also covered topics about relating to others - how to be a good friend, making good choices, positive conflict resolution and reinforcing our school value of kindness.

Next week, Shotover School will be holding their Year 5 and Year 6 School Camp in Glenorchy. Some of their activities will take place at Glenorchy School. We are looking forward to hosting small groups of Shotover students at a time over the two weeks that the camps are taking place. It will give our students the opportunity to meet and get to know children from another local school.
