Thank you for attending the goal setting interviews last week. Both our teachers enjoyed hearing how the year has started for your children and what we can do to help your child succeed at school this year. It is still our intention to hold student-led conferences in the last week of Term One as we have done in the past.

On Monday 18 March, NZEI is holding Paid Union Meetings for members to discuss next steps towards settling employment contracts. Glenorchy School will remain open on this day. We thank you for your continued support.

This week we have scaled down our swimming programme to 2 days a week. Swimming will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays until further notice. We are really fortunate to have a community pool and we would like to keep developing our children's swimming ability for as long as we can.

This week our Year 3 to Year 8 students will complete P.A.T. (Progressive Achievement Testing). These standardised tests allow teachers to establish whether your child is achieving to age expectations and that they are making expected progress in key learning areas. By analysing student responses we are able to establish a child's learning strengths and gaps so that we are able to plan our programmes to meet their needs.

There are a number of Senior students who have indicated they would like to participate in the Wakatipu Zone Triathlon on Tuesday 12 March.
