The children have all settled well back into school following the lockdown. The Play Music programme for the Junior Room started back last Tuesday and Kapa Haka begins again on Thursday. Students are preparing entries for the Glenorchy Flower Show. The Juniors have started an ecology topic investigating native birds in their habitat. It's as if we've never been away!

The Year 4 to Year 8 children had a great time at the recent Pukerau School Camp. Thank you to Mike, Chris, Lisa, Jessie and Anita for coming with us and being such able parent help. Thank you also to Gorettie for organising the menu and food prior to us setting off.

Now that Spring is here, we are getting back outside and into the school garden. On the last day of camp, we visited Pukerau Nursery to look at how they go about growing plants.

Next Tuesday afternoon, Nicky Gray from Enviro Schools, Anita and Caro will help the children plant seedlings to grow in the school nursery.

In conjunction with DOC, we are also looking at planting more trees along the boardwalk as we did last year. This is likely to be in the first week or two back at school but a date has not yet been confirmed. We will send out an email with the details as soon as the plans are finalised as we will need parent support with this.

Another project we are getting involved in is painting the beehives that are about to be set up at Camp Glenorchy. The team from Camp Glenorchy are keen for the school children to be involved in their new project. They will invite us over at key times so that the children can see honey being produced.

There are a number of jobs around the school grounds that need to be done so that we can really get our school garden programme running successfully this year. We are organising a school working bee for the Sunday afternoon of 31 October, starting at 1pm. Please put this date in your diary. Many hands make light work!


