#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I know if my child is a Year 0 or a Year 1?

Year Os - start in terms 3 or 4

Year 1s – start in term 1 or 2

However, there is a grey area – If your child starts in term 2 this gives them wiggle room and with discussion with the parents and the school, the student may be classified either way. At Glenorchy School we encourage all our term 2 students to be Year 0 and then do a full year at school as Year 1s the following year.

The official cut off date according to the Ministry of Education is June 1<sup>st</sup>.
